


The following instructions are from Adobe Reader version 9. Similar toolbars can be found in versions 7 and 8. You can also refer to your version's help menu.

Using the Typewriter Tool


- Choose Tools > Typewriter > Typewriter.
- Click over the desired area of the page and type.
- (Optional) Choose Tools > Typewriter > Show Typewriter Toolbar. Use these tools to change the size or position of the typed text.
- When finished, be sure to save your changes. It is recommended that you also print a copy of the completed form.

Using the Sticky Note Tool

- Click on the Comment  button near the top of the page, and then choose Add Sticky Note .
- Type your comment in the pop-up note. (Your comment remains if you close the note.)
- (Optional) Drag the sticky note icon or pop-up window to a new location (e.g., underneath or beside the question or paragraph you are commenting on).

Highlighting Text

- Click Tools > Comments and Markup in the top menu, and then choose Highlight Text Tool .

Note: The newer versions of Adobe Reader also make use of your computer's text to speech features. On the top menu, click on View > Read Out Loud > Activate Read Out Loud. Then repeat by clicking View > Read Out Loud, but this time, select your choice of either Read This Page Only or Read to End of Document. More details can be found in the Adobe Reader's help menu. Be sure to have your computer's sound turned on!

SESSION 5 READING ASSIGNMENTS - Important Point Reinforcements

Searching for the answers in your reading assignments and writing them here is not to just test your ability to fill in the blanks. When reading about things that can cause your soul to have to make changes it doesn't want to make, it will try to influence you to slide over certain things you have just read. This section of the Manual is to cause you to reread, locate the answers, and write them down. This forces your soul to spend more time on actual facts than it usually would. Listening to the CDs, reading the assigned books, and writing down answers increase your ability to retain what you need to remember to help you keep surrendering to God's great plans and purposes for your life.

BTP – Introduction Bridge and Chapter 1

√ If you have only understood the use of the Key of binding as being the action of binding Satan, consider the fact that there are no references in your Bible about Jesus or any of His disciples ever binding Satan or evil spirits. Jesus rebuked, silenced, or told evil spirits to go.

1. Satan has more spirits to send at you than you could possibly ever have time to bind during the rest of your life. Binding evil spirits is like trying to mop up an overflowing toilet without shutting off the water that keeps coming into it. It is much more productive to turn the water off behind the toilet before you try to deal with the mess that has been made. If you had flies coming in through a hole in your screen door, you could keep killing the flies one by one. Or, you could fix the hole and stop their point of access. This is our goal—turn off the water overflowing the toilet and fix the hole letting the pests enter!
2. Satan has already been defeated by Jesus Christ, but one of Satan's most effective tools to keep you from getting free in Christ is to keep you extremely busy. How does he do this?

3. You, as a believer, may never have been taught how to effectively use the Keys of the Kingdom to step out of your spiritual survival mentalities and into freedom. This doesn't have as much to do with your level of faith as it does with your level of what?

4. You are capable of placing intense faith in what? What causes you to do this?

5. So-called spiritual warfare *victories* that you believe you have won are often just voluntary concessions from Satan to keep you interested in what mode of thinking?

6. Your victories in spiritual warfare don't have as much to do with your level of faith as they do with your level of scriptural and spiritual understanding. What does this mean to you?

√ The terms that people use such as a *critical spirit*, a *controlling spirit*, and a *spirit of anger* or *rage* are not found in the Bible.

1. What are people generally exhibiting when they are extremely critical, controlling, or angry?

2. While deliverance is a scriptural truth, deliverance does nothing to affect what state of the human condition?

3. The authority of Jesus Christ can be spoken into action by a Christian to bring about deliverance, but deliverance is almost always temporary. What must happen before freedom is permanent?

√ Our minds and emotions have faithfully squirreled away all the personal details of our past traumas, complete with associated wrong beliefs, mind sets, and emotional reactions.

1. These unresolved traumas and all the personal details that our soul keeps so alive cause what three things to be birthed? These three things can remain so real to some of us that we lose all perspective of what fact?

2. Our memories are the only source of remaining power that these past traumas have. Why do you think this is so?

3. Why is it non-productive, even dangerous, to allow the unsurrendered soul to be a controlling factor in the healing of your memories?

4. Jesus wanted those who trusted in Him to be dependent upon what? He never wanted those who trust in Him to be dependent upon what other three things?

5. God will not override our souls' self-defense systems to heal us. Why not?

√ Trying to analyze and work through what your unsurrendered soul chooses to reveal to you will not heal you. Your soul has built strongholds to protect your wrong beliefs that it believes will protect and help you. This is false.

1. These strongholds protect your soul's belief that you are the way you are because of what? That you cannot be what? Why does it do this?

2. How does *synergy* apply to how you function as a Christian? Explain how the word *synergy* explains the sum of your efforts to cooperate with God to impact His Kingdom purposes.

3. What is the original meaning of the word *suffer(ing)* in the original Greek manuscripts of the Scriptures? Romans 8:17 tells us this: “*We must share His suffering if we are to share His glory*” (AMP). What is this verse actually saying when you reread it with the understanding of the original Greek meaning of the word *suffer(ing)*?

4. Jesus said that God would finish His work in you that He had started. What causes a problem with God being able to do that in your life?

√ The prayers in the books in your reading assignments have been deliberately written to be thought provoking.

1. What should you do with these prayers to get the most out of praying them?

2. What can you do to effectively use the binding and loosing prayers written for the reader to pray if you want to use them to pray for others?
