Using the Typewriter Tool

- Choose Tools > Typewriter > Typewriter.
- Click over the desired area of the page and type.
- (Optional) Choose Tools > Typewriter > Show Typewriter Toolbar. Use these tools to change the size or position of the typed text.
- When finished, be sure to save your changes. It is recommended that you also print a copy of the completed form.

Using the Sticky Note Tool

- Click on the Comment  button near the top of the page, and then choose Add Sticky Note .
- Type your comment in the pop-up note. (Your comment remains if you close the note.)
- (Optional) Drag the sticky note icon or pop-up window to a new location (e.g., underneath or beside the question or paragraph you are commenting on).

Highlighting Text

- Click Tools > Comments and Markup in the top menu, and then choose Highlight Text Tool .

Note: The newer versions of Adobe Reader also make use of your computer's text to speech features. On the top menu, click on View > Read Out Loud > Activate Read Out Loud. Then repeat by clicking View > Read Out Loud, but this time, select your choice of either Read This Page Only or Read to End of Document. More details can be found in the Adobe Reader's help menu. Be sure to have your computer's sound turned on!

READ ME FIRST

1. Welcome to your Liberty's Believers' Enrichment Program Session 6: The Unsundered Soul II. We recommend that you begin to record your personal thoughts and feelings as you review the CD teachings and work in your Session Manuals on the blank pages of paper on the left-hand side of this Manual. Or, you may prefer to use a hard-backed journal.
2. Be sure to date your thoughts! You will find the personal thoughts and notes you record to be a helpful baseline (a comparison to measure personal growth by) as you begin to see changes in your life. There are no spiritual yardsticks or thermometers that show how you are doing in life. Your proof of spiritual growth comes from seeing how you are currently handling life's lessons and trials compared to how you previously handled the same type of lessons and trials.
3. Liberty's Believers' Enrichment Program (hereafter referred to as LBE) Program requires that you read *Shattering Your Strongholds*, *Breaking the Power*, *Producing the Promise*, *The Unsundered Soul*, and *BEYOND Shattered Strongholds*, available either from Liberty Savard Ministries (hereinafter referred to as LSM) or from your local Christian bookstore. The Reading Assignments for each chapter should be carefully read before working with each Session study.

It is important that you read all of the Reading Assignments for each Session to grasp the *big picture* of the subject being presented before you begin to answer the questions. **The purpose of this LBE Program is that you learn to understand the concepts and principles in each Session. To just search out and fill in the blanks from your CD and Reading Assignment questions will totally defeat that learning process.**

4. **If you have an original *Shattering Your Strongholds* (NOT the newer *Shattering Your Strongholds-Revised* printed in 2005),** turn to pages 48-50 in your original version. Strongholds are a soulish catchall, or mental trap, constructed of and reinforced by the unsundered soul's logic, reasoning, arguments, rationalizations, justifications,

defensiveness, and denial that defend and protect whatever the soul has chosen to believe. Make a note in the margins of pages 48-50 in your original SYS that *stronghold* is an umbrella term, not an specific-issue term. Then cross out the names of the strongholds as listed there.

5. **If you have an original *Shattering Your Strongholds* (see above)**, also turn to pages 70-72. Strike out everything after the heading called *Binding the Strongman* on page 70 through the third paragraph on page 72. This teaching about the strongman (the understanding I had in 1991 when this manuscript was first completed) has been completely revised with considerable backup research. The new teaching can be found in ***The Unsundered Soul***, Chapter 5, and will also be addressed in Session 7 of Module 2.
6. Read the Glossary of Terms (see Table of Contents). Some of these terms will not be fully discussed until later Sessions, but start thinking about them now.
7. Read and act on the Important Point Reinforcements in this Session 6 Manual.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BELIEVERS

Believers' Enrichment Students should complete the Reading Assignments and study the Important Point Reinforcements (reading and acting upon examples and exercises) on two levels.

- a. You should first consider everything you read, pray, act upon, answer, and do in this study with regard to your own personal growth.
- b. You should then consider everything you read, pray, act upon, answer, and do with regard to being able to share it with others.
- c. Understand that Liberty will answer questions from LBE students on issues related to this message as long as they are using and sharing the message.

You will not be able to fully benefit from this message in a pure and effective manner if you choose to deny your own personal struggles. Note that the previous sentence did not say that you cannot be a victorious Christian if you have struggles. As a dedicated and motivated Believer, you should always be trying to face and surrender your struggles and issues to God which will accomplish two things for you: 1) Freedom from them, and 2) deeper understanding of how to help others to do the same thing.

The more you understand where your struggles are coming from and what you can do about them (or what you can stop doing to contribute to them), the easier it will be for you to begin to deal with them. Every victory you achieve, no matter how small, will help you understand how to show others how to overcome, too.

Paul has given us such a good example of how he was serving God and ministering to others while struggling within himself over the wrong decisions that his old nature still wanted to make. He was already out preaching the Gospel with signs and wonders following him when he admitted the following. In Romans 7:15-25 (in part), we read this (*The Message*):

“What I don't understand about myself is that I decide one way, but then I act another, doing things I absolutely despise. So if I can't be trusted to figure out what is best for myself and then do it, it becomes obvious that God's command is necessary ... I realize that I don't have what it takes. I can will it, but I can't do it. I decide to do good, but I don't really do it; I decide not to do bad, but then I do it anyway. My decisions, such as they are, don't result in actions. Something has gone wrong deep within me and gets the better of me every time ... I truly delight in God's commands, but it's pretty obvious that not all of me joins in that delight. Parts of me covertly rebel, and just when I least expect it, they take charge. I've tried everything and nothing helps. I'm at the end of my rope. Is there no one who can do anything for me? Isn't that the real question? The answer, thank God, is that Jesus Christ can and does. He acted to set things right in this life of contradictions where I want to serve God with all my heart and mind, but am pulled by the influence of sin to do something totally different.”

Paul freely admitted his struggles and expressed his desire to find the answer to overcoming them, all the while preaching with signs and miracles following his ministry. Struggling with unresolved issues in your life *can* hold you back if you are in denial of them, deceived by them, or refusing to deal with them. Fully cooperating with the Lord to overcome your struggles as you

move on towards your destiny enhance your ability to share with others how to successfully overcome their struggles.

This is a circumstance where an inward right attitude and motivation of the heart/soul outweighs outward behaviors being exhibited.

When used consistently and with commitment, the prayer principles in this LBE program will help you overcome any denial and deception of your own vulnerabilities, weaknesses, and struggles. These prayer principles will also help you overcome any discouragement or doubt you might have about whether or not you can overcome vulnerabilities and struggles that have been in your life for some time—guiding you into spiritual victory!

Using these prayer principles will cause buried things in your soul to rise to the surface of your understanding which may create some anger and confusion in your thought processes. This can be quite startling, even fearful, to some people. But consider this: If you have an infection or foreign object festering in your body, covering it over, denying it, or hiding it with clean bandages and fresh clothes is neither effective nor productive. The infection or the foreign object needs to be uncovered and dealt with.

One of the best things about this message is that the binding side of the prayers will hold you steady and stabilize you while the loosing side of the prayers will begin to pry out the offending junk your soul is trying to hide within itself. While you may feel like things are falling apart on one hand, you will feel Christ's steadying and stabilizing of your life on the other hand. This dynamic will carry you through to spiritual victory.

The Keys of the Kingdom can help each one of us begin to dismantle our souls' attempts to thwart God's plans and purposes for our lives and allow us to become powerfully motivated teachers and leaders desiring to help others. The more you understand about the Keys of the Kingdom/Unsurrendered Soul message and how it can work in your own life, the better you will be able to share it. This is NOT a message that can effectively be used just by memorization or by theory. Both the enemy and your soul will mess with that kind of an effort every time.

As a LBE student, you will be mainly working on one level to begin with: considering everything you read, pray, act upon, answer, and do with this message as it affects your own personal growth. As you are doing this, you will almost always find yourself wanting to share what you are learning with others.

As you stay consistent and committed in praying with the binding and loosing prayers and reading the Word (both actions reinforce each other), you will find that you want to cooperate with God more than you ever have. You will actually *want to do* whatever He tells you, instead of just thinking that you *have to do* what He tells you. Your every *want-to* will have spiritual hands and feet instead of just hopeful thoughts floating around in your head. You will also find that you have less anxiety and fear about sharing with others, and you will have less doubt in yourself regarding your ability to do that effectively.

Not everyone in the body of Christ will formally teach the Word of God from pulpits and podiums. Nor will everyone else seek out structured teaching and learning situations on how to change their lives. This is why God has created the body of Christ like a human body. If all of our parts were eyes and fingers, how would we speak and walk? If all of our parts were mouths and feet, how would we hear and see? It takes many different body of Christ *parts* to teach, share, and

be available to others to reach the whole world. How exciting it is that you are about to move further into your specific role as an end-time laborer for the Kingdom.

As a LBE student and as a child of God, you have some very specific things to do and some very specific people that God wants you to share the Gospel and your life with. These prayer principles will help you to get your *stuff* out of your way, dismantle your unsurrendered soul's tricks, and loose distractions and reactions from both your soul and the enemy. You will be ready to begin living in joyous expectation and to be used by God in ways you have never dreamed of.
